CARIBOO DISTRICT - BRITISH COLUMBIA

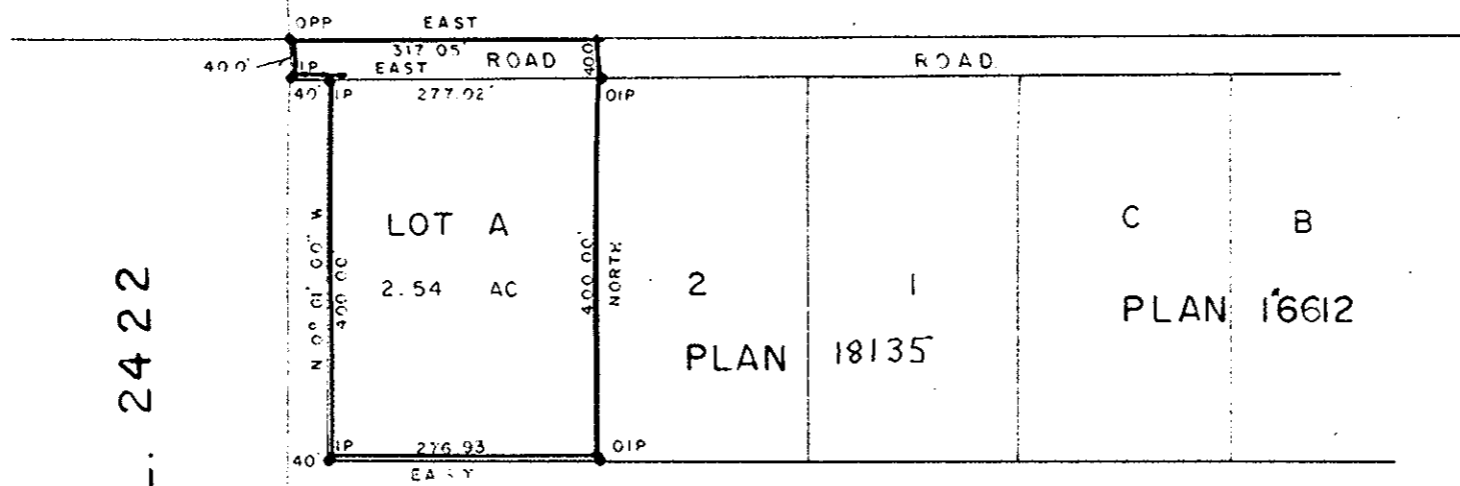
