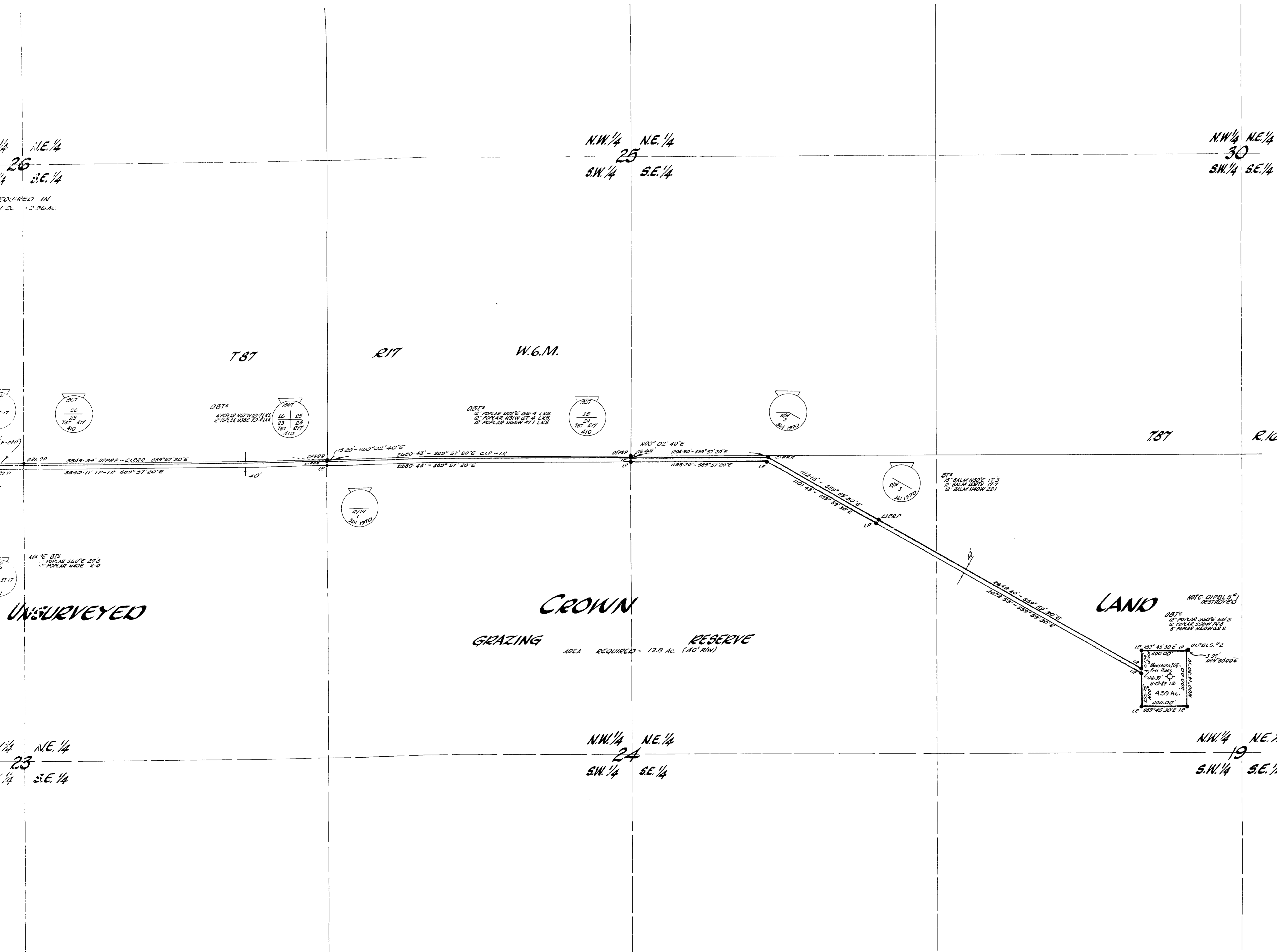


**PLAN OF RIGHT-OF-WAY THROUGH
