

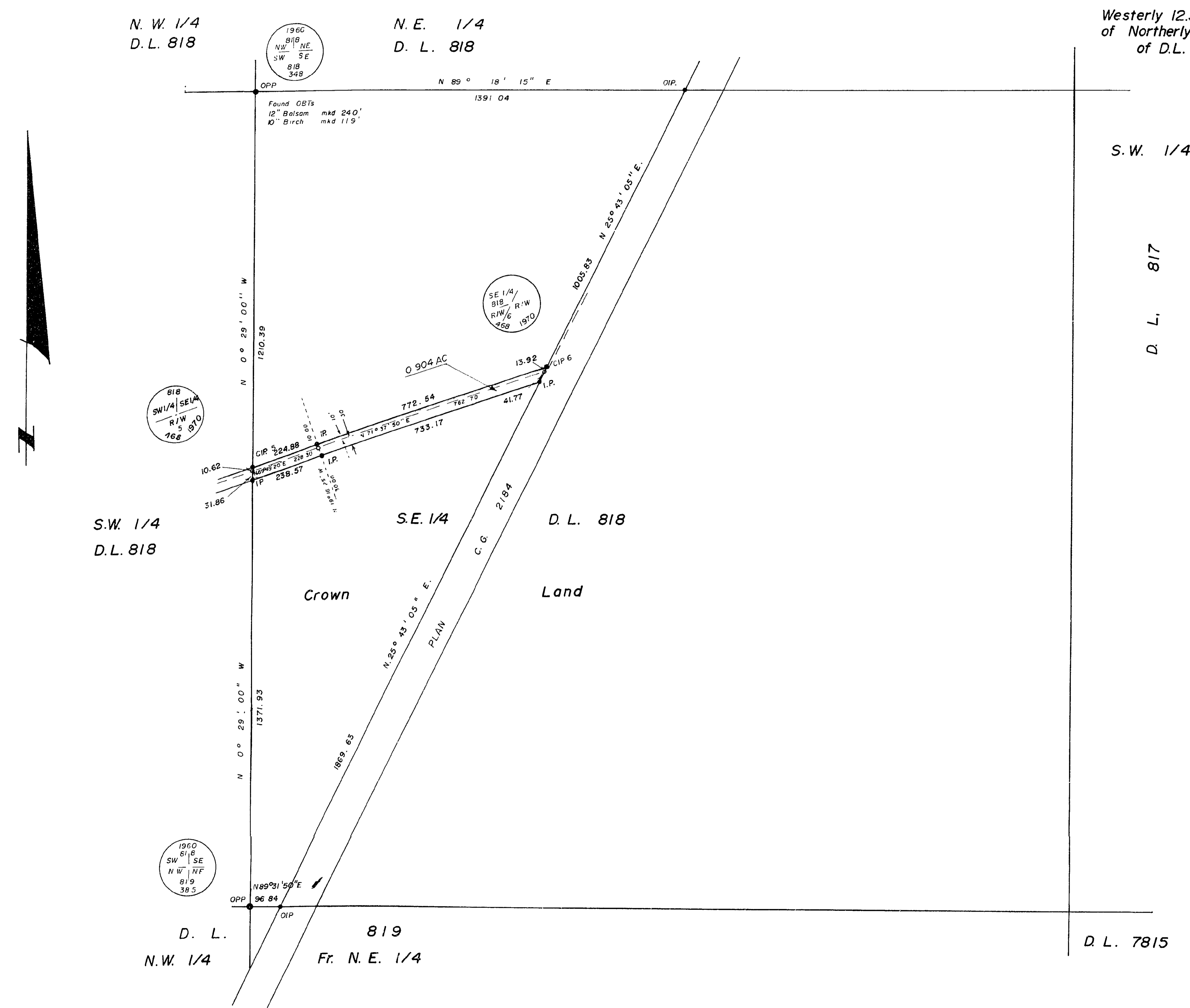
PLAN OF RIGHT OF WAY
