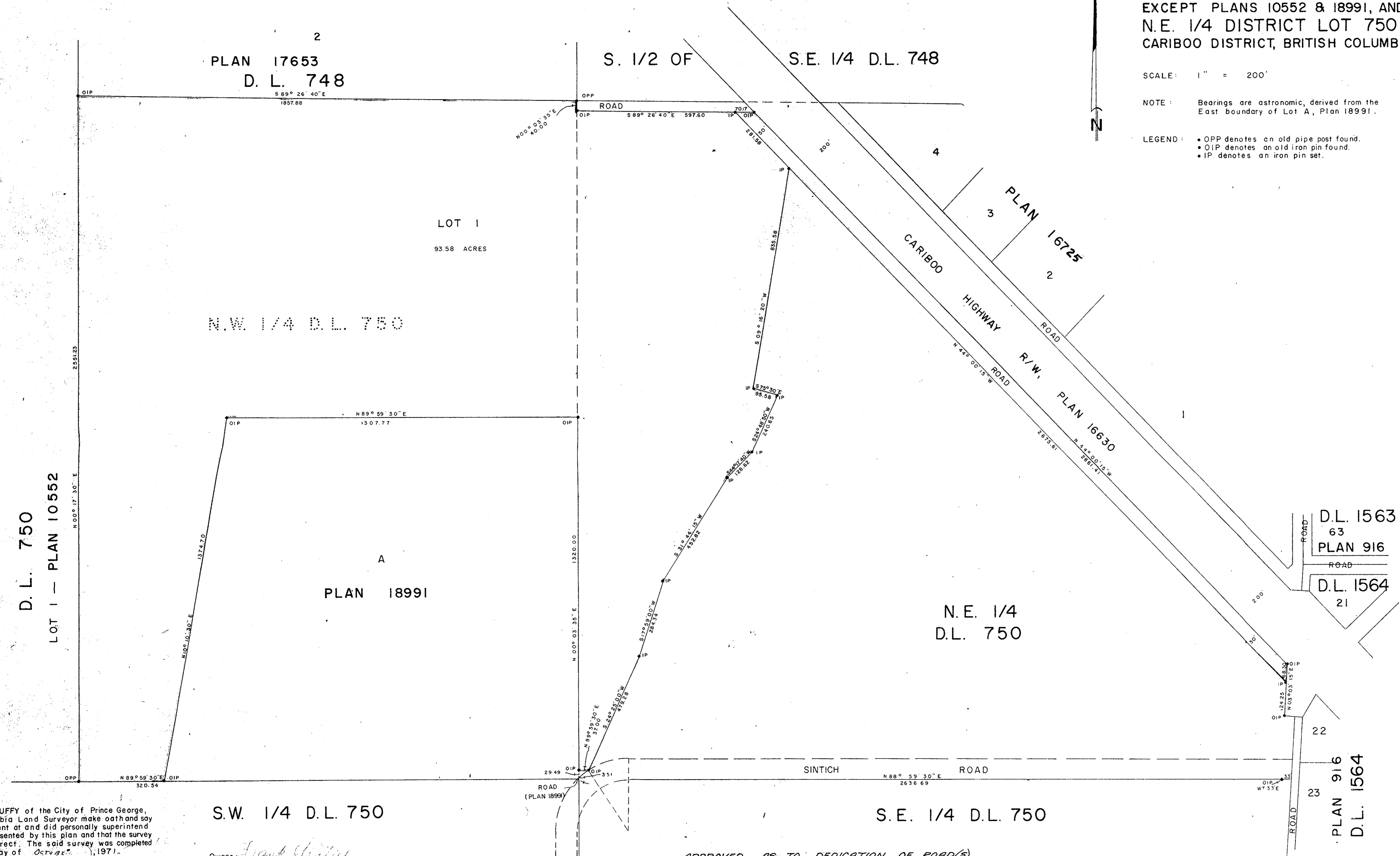


PLAN OF SUBDIVISION OF
