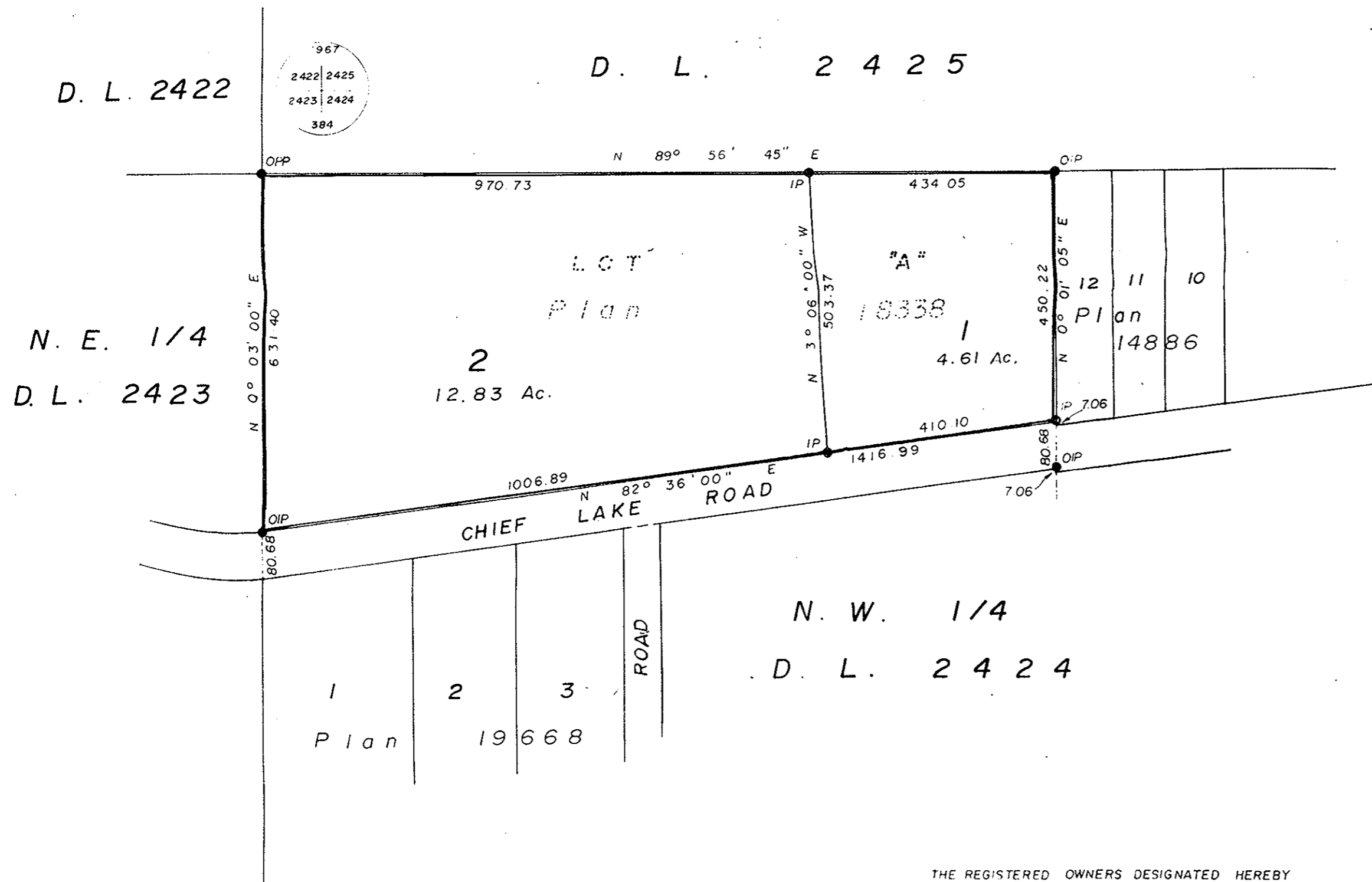
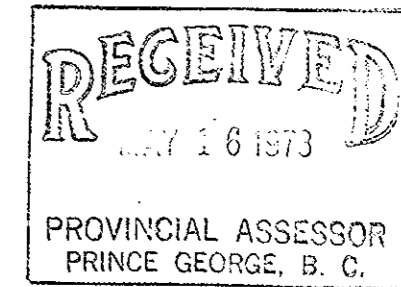


PLAN OF SUBDIVISION
