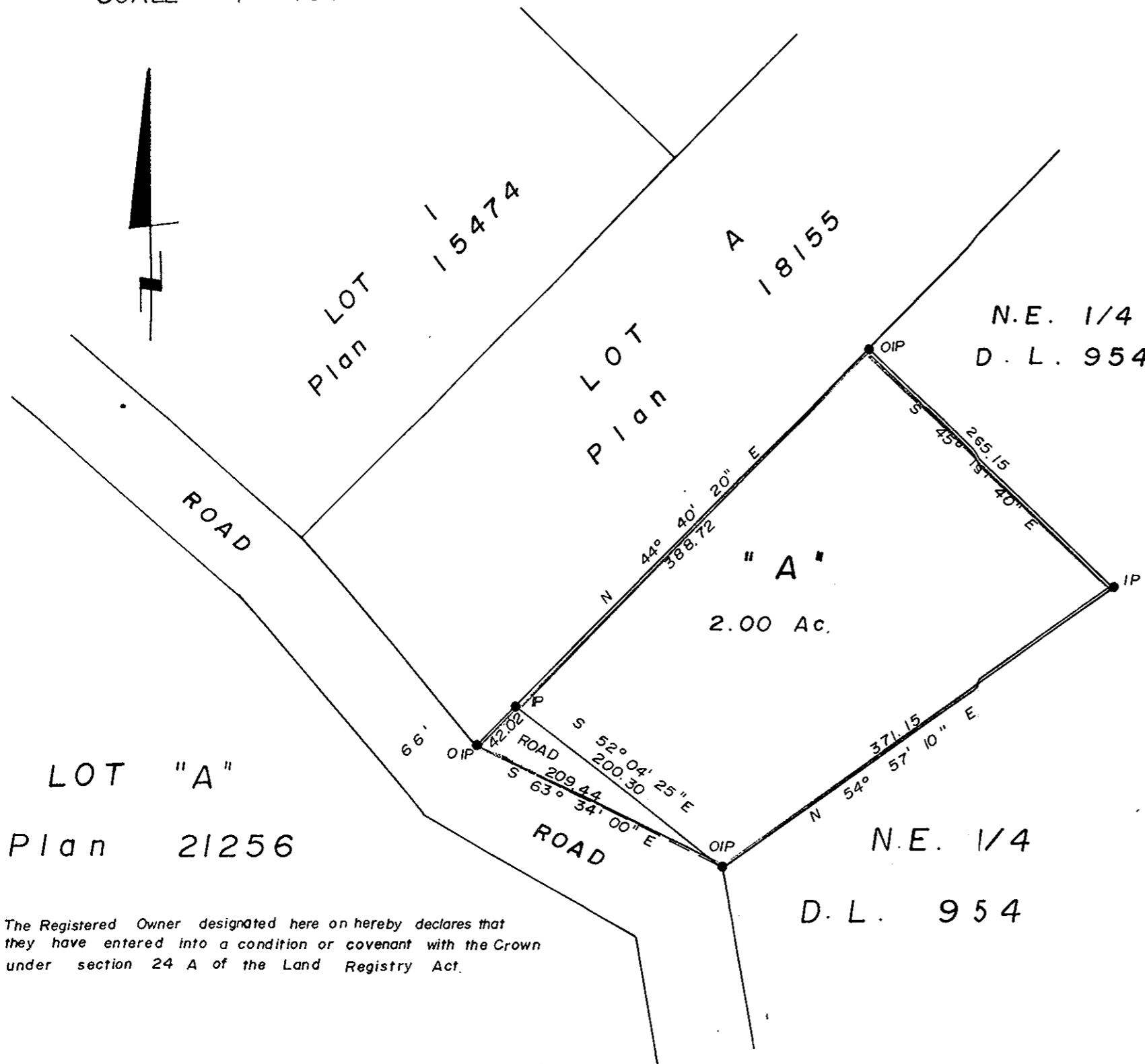


PLAN OF SUBDIVISION
