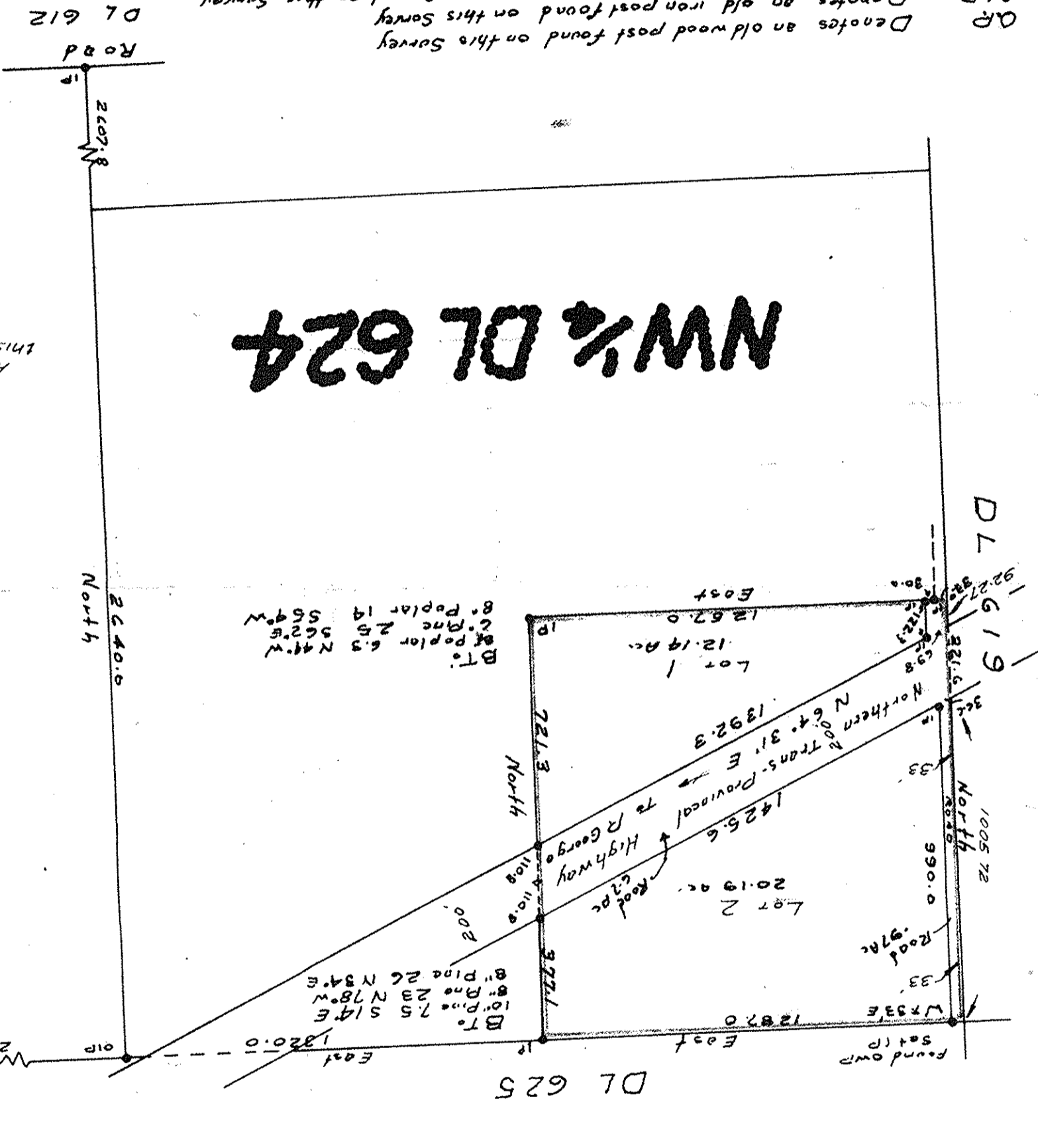


**PLAN OF SUBDIVISION
